Project Committee. The Board of Directors may appoint a Project Committee consisting of a minimum of (5) Directors and up to (8) Directors. The President, Treasurers, Sponsorship Manager, and the Field and Grounds Manger shall be ex-officio members of the Committee. The Committee shall be responsible for investigating ways and means of prioritizing, planning, and financing the Local Leagues major projects. The committee will work together to develop project priorities and submit their recommendations to the Board of Directors for final approval. The Project Committee is required to meet or communicate regularly outside of the regular scheduled board meetings to be able to provide the board of directors with accurate project updates.

Finance Committee. The Board of Directors may appoint a Finance Committee consisting of a minimum of (3) Directors and up to (5) Directors. The President and Treasurers shall be ex-officio members of the committee. The committee shall be responsible for the organization’s financial planning and budget process. They will also work together to develop strategic plans for investments for future financial growth and develop financial management mechanisms to minimize financial risk. The committee is required to meet or communicate regularly outside of the regular scheduled board meetings to be able to accurately fulfill the duties of the committee.

Sponsorship Committee. The Board of Directors may appoint a Sponsorship Committee consisting of a minimum of four (4) Directors. The Sponsorship Committee shall be responsible for securing team sponsorships by reaching out and developing relationships with local businesses to obtain and secure the necessary funds to sponsor teams within the Local League. The committee shall also be responsible for collaborating with the Project and Finance Committees to develop other sponsorship needs within the organization. The committee should be aware and communicate the various sponsorship levels available and any other sponsorship opportunities available to the community. The Sponsorship Committee is responsible for tracking sponsorships and providing the Treasurer with sponsorship commitments to ensure invoices are sent out. The committee is responsible for ensuring all signs and banners are obtained and hung for each season. It is the responsibility of the Sponsorship Committee to work with other committees to ensure all teams are sponsored and that uniforms are designed and ordered for the upcoming season. All decisions that involve financials or significant changes in processes should be proposed and approved by the board of directors. The Committee is required to meet regularly outside of the regular scheduled board meetings to be able to accurately fulfill the duties assigned to the committee.

Facilities and Grounds Committee. The Board of Directors may appoint a Facilities and Grounds Committee consisting of a minimum of four (4) Directors and other appointed Regular Members. One Committee member shall be named the Facilities and Grounds Manager. The committee shall be responsible for recommendations on repairs

and improvements, performing or scheduling regular maintenance activities, and supervising the scheduling and performance of all approved or active projects. The committee shall be responsible for the care and maintenance of the playing fields, buildings, and grounds. The Facilities and Grounds Committee shall operate within the approved budget for repairs and maintenance. If significant improvements or repairs are required, it is the responsibility of the committee to obtain the necessary proposals and quotes to present to the board of directors. Recommendations for major projects must be approved first by the Project and Finance Committees and assigned a priority prior to seeking board approval. The committee is required to meet or communicate regularly outside of the regular scheduled board meetings and should all be aware and informed of all activities planned or in progress.

Umpire Committee. The Board of Directors may appoint an Umpire Committee consisting of two (2) Directors. One member of the Committee shall be named Umpire-In-Chief and shall serve as coordinator of the Local League umpire program. The Committee shall advise the President and Board of Directors on the Local League umpire program, recommend umpires to serve during regular season and other tournament events. It shall recruit, review, and retain umpires as necessary for the League. Responsible for communicating any rule changes to the League umpires, managers, and coaches. Establish and implement a basic umpire training program for umpires that is consistent with Little League guidelines.

Scheduling Committee. The Board of Directors may appoint a Scheduling Committee consisting of a minimum of four (4) Directors. One member of the committee shall be named the Scheduling Manager, and the Committee shall be responsible for working with the League Chairpersons for each division, the VP of Baseball and VP of Softball and the Tournaments Committee to ensure scheduling of games and practices best utilize the fields. The Committee is responsible for ensuring that all main complex fields are utilized to their fullest during weeknight games. The Committee is responsible for scheduling volunteers for the concession stand and preparing the Board Member On-Duty schedule. The Manager is responsible for maintaining all schedules and communicating changes and works with teams and volunteers to reschedule any rained-out games. The committee is responsible for maintaining and sharing the “official” calendar for all GABSA events.

Concession Committee. The Board of Directors may appoint a Concession Committee consisting of five (5) Directors. One member of the committee shall be named the Concession Manager, and the Committee shall be responsible for the successful operations of the concession facilities. The Committee shall organize the purchase of concession products, be responsible for managing the concession sales at league events and work with the Scheduling Committee to ensure volunteers are scheduled to work the concession stand during all league events. The Committee will work with vendors to maintain inventory of products and to receive deliveries. It shall organize and keep records of sales and purchases and provide receipts and invoices to the Treasurer as necessary. Seeks concession-related offers, including discounts and bulk-purchasing opportunities ensuring the best prices can be offered to League participants. Plan and coordinate cleaning and other activities at opening and closing of concession stand seasons. Ensure all signage and instructions are up-to-date and that all equipment is in working order. The committee is required to meet and/or communicate regularly outside of the regular scheduled board meetings to ensure the duties of the committee are fulfilled successfully.

The official is responsible to ensure that ALL volunteers meet the requirements of successfully completing the background checks and volunteer forms required by the League, State, and Little League International. The individual is responsible for maintaining online records of all completed forms and uploading to the Little League preferred provider, J.D Palatine. As background checks are completed the League official must review the results to ensure any red flags indicated on the JDP Platform are permitted by Little League Regulation. The Official must present any red flags to the League President or Board of Directors to determine if the individual is fit to participate as a volunteer.
