Old Business:

- Opening Day Recap

- T-ball
 - New Tanner Tee that was bought last year has walked off. Bill S has loaned his tee to the T-ball division for use until a new one is purchased. Jake S also mentioned the shed lock at Kauffman is broken, it no longer stays locked. Jake S made a motion to purchase a new lock and a new Tanner Tee, Jesse D seconded and motion passed.
